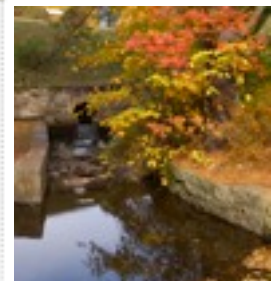

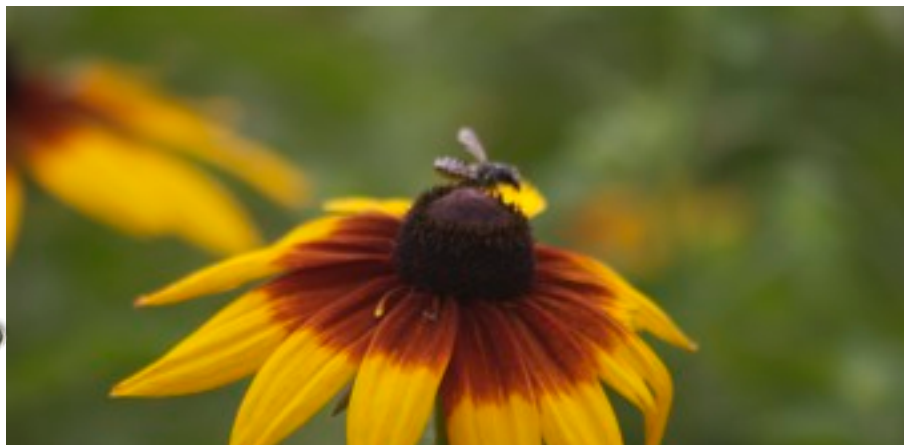
**ESQUIRE ASSIST - YEAR 21 AND BEYOND**

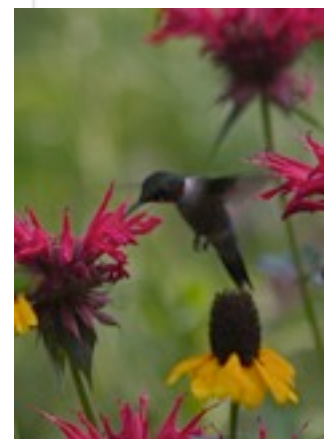
reliable service and answers to your questions.
